BridgeWork Community Impact Partnership Agreement

1. Purpose of Agreement

This Community Impact Partnership Agreement ("Agreement") establishes a collaborative relationship between Many Ways Up LLC, through its BridgeWork platform ("BridgeWork"), and [Nonprofit Organization Name] ("Community Partner").

The purpose of this partnership is to support community improvement projects by allowing Community Partner to identify needs, projects, or tasks that would benefit its organization and the communities it serves.

BridgeWork provides the platform, coordination, and funding support necessary to help facilitate completion of approved community projects.

2. Roles and Responsibilities

BridgeWork Responsibilities — BridgeWork agrees to:

- Provide access to the BridgeWork platform for identifying and coordinating community improvement projects.
- Provide funding support for approved community tasks when funding is available.
- Coordinate task opportunities and payment processes for approved participants.
- Maintain records related to BridgeWork-funded projects.
- Communicate project status and completion information with Community Partner.

Community Partner Responsibilities — Community Partner agrees to:

- Identify community improvement needs, projects, or tasks that support its mission and benefit the individuals or communities it serves.
- Review and approve tasks submitted for consideration through BridgeWork.
- Provide reasonable information needed to describe the project or task.
- Confirm whether completed projects have met the identified need.
- Communicate any concerns regarding safety, access, or project requirements.

3. No Employment Relationship

The parties acknowledge and agree that Community Partner is not hiring, employing, or contracting with individuals completing BridgeWork-funded tasks.

Community Partner is not responsible for:

- Recruiting task participants.
- Paying task participants.
- Managing payment processing.
- Creating employment agreements.
- Providing wages, benefits, or payroll services.

BridgeWork manages the coordination and payment process associated with BridgeWork-funded tasks.

4. No Fundraising Requirement

Participation in this partnership does not require Community Partner to:

- Raise funds for BridgeWork.
- Promote BridgeWork fundraising campaigns.
- Solicit donations on behalf of BridgeWork.
- Provide financial contributions.

Community Partner maintains full discretion regarding its fundraising activities and organizational priorities.

5. Community Partner Independence

Nothing in this Agreement requires Community Partner to endorse, advertise, or promote Many Ways Up LLC or BridgeWork.

Community Partner maintains full control over:

- Its mission.
- Its programs.
- Its services.
- The projects and needs it identifies.

Participation in this partnership does not create a legal partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between the parties.

6. Project Approval and Scope

Projects submitted through BridgeWork may include, but are not limited to:

- Property cleanup.
- Organization projects.
- Community space improvements.

- Donation sorting.
- Facility support tasks.
- Neighborhood improvement projects.

BridgeWork and Community Partner may communicate regarding project details, timelines, requirements, and completion standards.

7. Safety and Project Requirements

The parties agree that projects should be appropriate for the participants completing them.

Projects should avoid tasks involving unreasonable risk, including but not limited to:

- Hazardous materials.
- Dangerous equipment.
- Unsafe working conditions.
- Activities requiring specialized licenses or certifications unless properly arranged.

Either party may decline participation in any project that presents safety, compliance, or operational concerns.

8. Use of Name and Recognition

Neither party may use the other party's name, logo, or public materials without prior permission.

If both parties agree, Community Partner may be recognized as a BridgeWork community partner.

Any recognition is intended to highlight collaboration and community impact and does not represent endorsement of commercial products or services.

9. Term and Termination

This Agreement begins on the Effective Date and remains active until terminated by either party.

Either party may end this Agreement by providing written notice to the other party.

Termination will not affect any completed projects or obligations already established before termination.

10. Relationship of the Parties

The parties acknowledge that:

- Many Ways Up LLC operates BridgeWork as a technology platform.
- Community Partner is an independent nonprofit organization.
- This Agreement establishes a collaborative community impact relationship.
- Neither party has authority to bind or represent the other party.

11. Agreement Acceptance

By signing below, the parties acknowledge that they understand and agree to the terms of this BridgeWork Community Impact Partnership Agreement.
